





The Mounts Baths Photographs - Bee Jackson

In April a group of 5 were lucky enough to go and photograph The Mounts Baths, an art deco swimming pool in Northampton. The visit had been booked 2 years ago, but had been cancelled twice due to covid lockdowns, so it was great to finally get there!



The pool was built in 1936, at a cost of £52,000 and it is now a Grade II listed building. Its construction was overseen by a committee headed by W.J Bassett-Lowke , of the famous 78 Derngate.



When you enter you can't help but be wowed by the 8 parabolic arches that span the pool and the colour. We were very lucky that the sun came out in the late afternoon, and the light flooded in through the large side windows, creating beautiful shadows across the walls and pool.



There is also a very stylish Turkish plunge bath with steam rooms with black and ivory ceramic tiles, which we were also allowed to wander around.

It was a real privilege to be allowed to photograph here, and I'm now on the hunt for more historic buildings in Northampton!

He started to analyse the structures, spaces (and places) and the systems that shape our lives and our landscapes and he focused on the area where we live at the interface of nature and culture.

This body of work is about the uncommon beauty of the urban landscape on foggy nights. The various colour and lights appear one by one in the night scenes.



He accidentally stumbled upon these elements, and it was like being transported into another world. The world moves slower with fog and lots of things disappear into the darkness. It is within this landscape that he has found solace and peace within himself as his camera turns to the unusual attractiveness of the night.



Kyle Kim



As a photographer, he works tirelessly to push beyond the limitations of exposure time and aperture width, in order to shine light into dark places. The emotions that he is trying to evoke meaningful. Photography is the tool he uses to communicate these feelings. Kyle graduated an MFA Photography, and is currently pursuing for contract work.

Desiree Dolron is a Dutch photographer and filmmaker. Her oeuvre ranges from documentary photography and still life to portraiture and film.Throughout her career, Dolron has been investigating themes such as

Dolron was awarded the Laureate Prix de Rome, Amsterdam, The Netherlands (1996); in 2019 she has been honoured with the title of Artist of the Year by the American friends of the Museums in Israel, New York.
